The dare this year is 'Dare to Be Dedicated, with the focus of challenging the students to be dedicated to God, the church, and people. One of our biggest focuses here at Dare Ministries is discipleship. We want students in both high school and college to know what it means to walk with Jesus daily and be able to share their faith with others. We want to see young people walking in the power of the Gospel. We want them to be prepared to serve as the Lord leads, and work across denominational lines to bless others and unify the body of Christ.
